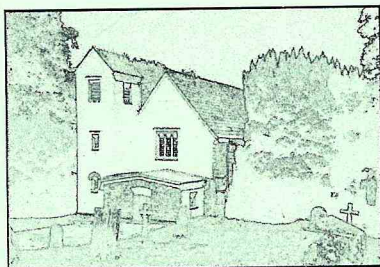
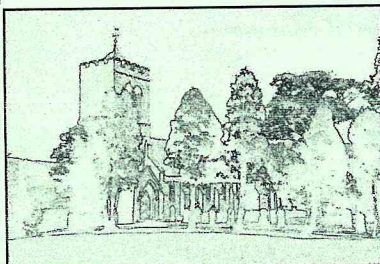

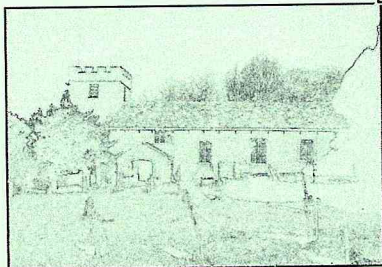

EXPECTATIONS

So this is Christmas
And what have you done?
Another year over
And a new one just begun

These are the opening words of a now, very familiar Christmas pop song composed and performed by John Lennon. The song, like many other Christmas pop hits, has become part of many people's traditional Christmas background music.

But as the early part of January passes and the Christmas season draws to an end at Epiphany, the question in the opening words of John Lennon's song is both poignant and appropriate. The Christmas season has come and passed, another year is over and what have we done with it?

Another year over...there can be no doubt that the year 2016 has been eventful and has raised concerns and worries for 2017 and the future. It is a year in which the United Kingdom has voted by referendum to leave the European Union; it is the year in which Donald Trump has been chosen as the President-elect and whom many consider to be unsuitable for such an important and powerful role; it is the year in which so many well-known figures have died that people are asking if this is significant.

Getting to know Jesus better...

We are now in chapter 11 and 12 of the book of Mark
New Living Translation of the Bible - Notes are by Matt Rich

27 Again they entered Jerusalem. As Jesus was walking through the Temple area, the leading priests, the teachers of religious law, and the elders came up to him. 28 They demanded, "By what authority are you doing all these things? Who gave you the right to do them?" 29 "I'll tell you by what authority I do these things if you answer one question," Jesus replied. 30 "Did John's authority to baptise come from heaven, or was it merely human? Answer me!" 31 They talked it over among themselves. "If we say it was from heaven, he will ask why we didn't believe John. 32 But do we dare say it was merely human?" For they were afraid of what the people would do, because everyone believed that John was a prophet. 33 So they finally replied, "We don't know." And Jesus responded, "Then I won't tell you by what authority I do these things."

Jesus knew that these people weren't really interested in the answer to their question - all they wanted was to make Jesus say something that they could use against Him, so they could arrest Him and kill Him. Jesus simply asked them a question that put them in the same sort of situation they had put Him in. He told them if they answered His question He would answer theirs. Jesus can see what is the real reason and motivation behind the things we do and say - we might fool others but we can't fool God! It is important for us to decide who we really want to live for and serve - Jesus or ourselves. Jesus can see right through us and knows the truth.

Mark 12

Then Jesus began teaching them with stories: "A man planted a vineyard. He built a wall around it, dug a pit for pressing out the grape juice, and built a lookout tower. Then he leased the vineyard to tenant farmers and moved to another country. 2 At the time of the grape

This story that Jesus told is all about how God the Father sent various prophets to tell the Jewish people how they could know Him - but how many of them ignored and rejected the people God sent. Then God the Father sent Jesus (God the Son) to us - the most precious person He could send.

harvest, he sent one of his servants to collect his share of the crop. 3 But the farmers grabbed the servant, beat him up, and sent him back empty-handed. 4 The owner then sent another servant, but they insulted him and beat him over the head. 5 The next servant he sent was killed. Others he sent were either beaten or killed, 6 until there was only one left - his son whom he loved dearly. The owner finally sent him, thinking, 'Surely they will respect my son.'

7 "But the tenant farmers said to one another, 'Here comes the heir to this estate. Let's kill him and get the estate for ourselves!' 8 So they grabbed him and murdered him and threw his body out of the vineyard. 9 "What do you suppose the owner of the vineyard will do?" Jesus asked. "I'll tell you - he will come and kill those farmers and lease the vineyard to others. 10 Didn't you ever read this in the Scriptures?, "The stone that the builders rejected has now become the cornerstone. 11 This is the Lord's doing, and it is wonderful to see."

12 The religious leaders wanted to arrest Jesus because they realised he was telling the story against them - they were the wicked farmers. But they were afraid of the crowd, so they left him and went away.

Jesus explained that even though God sent His Son, they would not listen to Him and they would decide to kill Him... but Jesus explained that God would punish them for killing Him and that God would allow people from other nations to get to know Him. Jesus is talking about us (who aren't Jews) getting to know Him. After Jesus died and came alive again, knowing peace with God became possible for people of every country! Before this happened you had to change and become a Jew, but now that was all going to be different and the door to know peace with God was to be thrown open wide to people of all nations.

Often we read that the normal people were on Jesus' side, they liked Him because they felt that He was for them and not against them! It was generally the religious leaders that were so against Jesus because He kept telling them that they had got it wrong!

Lowick Parish Council

The last Parish Council meeting was held on 17 November. Councillor Joanne Edmondson was nominated and unanimously accepted by councillors present as Vice Chairperson for 2016/2017.

Fran Richardson gave a presentation on Neighbourhood and Community Led Plans which will assist Lowick PC to develop a local, action based plan to address issues within the parish. It is hoped that the local community will work together to consider their needs for the future, and to develop an action plan to help achieve their aspirations. This will be considered further at the next, and subsequent meetings. Your help will be invaluable during this process.

Councillor Mitchell advised (again) anyone wishing to access superfast broadband needs to contact their supplier – it won't 'just happen'!

District Councillor Anne Hall gave a report on the X11/X12 bus service. Continued fund raising is vital to maintain the service which serves a social as well as a practical need.

The Council will be raising the issue of the accessibility to fire hydrants with the Chief Fire Officer following the difficulties discovered following the horrific fire at Esps Farm. It has also been highlighted that the fire service will come and assess and fit, free of charge, smoke alarms in properties. So, use this service if it will benefit you.

The Council has noted complaints about speeding through Lowick Bridge and the potential danger this poses, and it will form part of its liaison with Highways. Councillor Longmire suggested a 'Please Drive with Care' sign as one option.

The next Parish Council meeting will be on 19 January at 7.30pm in Lowick Community Hall.

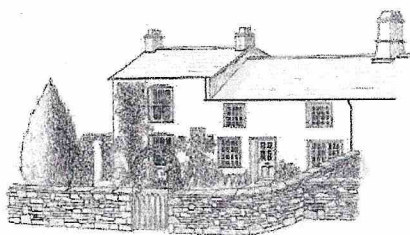

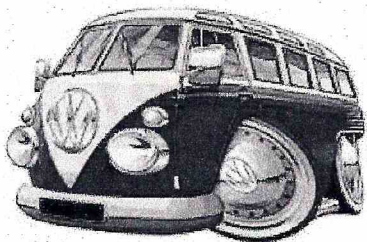
