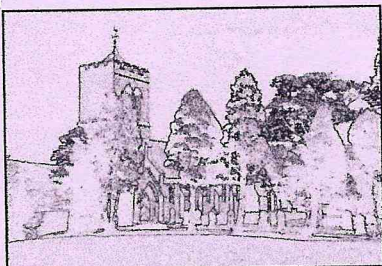

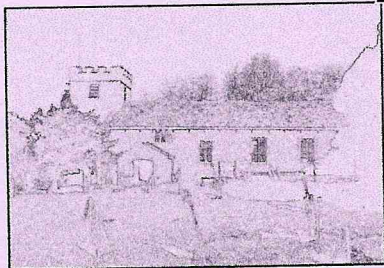

Dear Friends,

Green House Farm, LA12 8HN.

I think my abiding memory of this last weekend and Moving Mountains will be from Penny Bridge School on Friday. A group of us had been in school launching 'Open the Book' and had acted out the story of the Prodigal Son. After much hilarity with a 'herd' of snorting pigs (6 children complete with pig ears) and Brian Streeter with a tea towel on his head, the children sang the Easter song they had been learning. It was an amazingly joyous song which the children obviously loved singing, so much so that they spontaneously carried on singing as they walked out of the hall and the refrain 'Jesus is alive, Jesus is alive' rang in our ears as we packed up. Fantastic!

This new month of April begins on Easter Day, that day when the anxious, frightened, confused followers of Jesus began to learn that there was the possibility of a new beginning. Jesus was no longer in the tomb. He had risen!

Years ago, a lawyer called Frank Morrison set out to look at the evidence in order to disprove the resurrection. But something happened to him. Not only did he find the evidence supporting the resurrection overwhelming, but more than that, as he believed in and trusted Jesus, he found that a new life had begun.

When I faced cancer some years ago and didn't know what was going to happen, I thought a lot about death. Samuel Johnson once said, 'When a man knows he is to be hanged in a fortnight, it concentrates his mind wonderfully!' Sometimes I would have huge doubts as to whether anything I had believed was true. As I read the Bible and looked for my own 'evidence' I found that the resurrection came to mean something very personal. Jesus had been through death but had been raised, and I learnt again that the living Jesus was the only One Who understood, Who would be at my side and Who could take me through the valley of the shadow, into the life beyond.

I love the words of Billy Graham about his own death, 'I shall be more alive than I am now. I will just have changed my address'!

Getting to know Jesus better...

This month we are beginning a new book about Jesus written by one of Jesus' followers called John

English Standard Version of the Bible

Notes by Matt Rich, pastor of Bethany Christian Church, Ulverston

In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with God, and the Word was God. He was in the beginning with God. All things were made through him, and without him was not any thing made that was made. In him was life, and the life was the light of men. The light shines in the darkness, and the darkness has not overcome it.

John begins his book about Jesus in a way that seems confusing, until we realise that "the Word" is a name that John is using to describe Jesus. We know this because a little later in this chapter John wrote, "And the Word became flesh and dwelt among us". It all makes much more sense when we insert the name of Jesus every time it says "the Word"!

We can now see some amazing truths about Jesus...

- 1. He didn't just start his existence at the first Christmas... He existed in the beginning, before time began*
- 2. He was with God and He was God. Here we see a description of the trinity, that God is made up of more than one person - One God, made up of 3 persons. God the Father, God the Son (Jesus) and God the Holy Spirit.*
- 3. He was involved in the creation of the world, in fact it says that all things were made through Him!*

There was a man sent from God, whose name was John. He came as a witness, to bear witness about the light, that all might believe through him. He was not the light, but came to bear witness about the light.

Jesus is called "the light" - He shines in the darkness of our world, in the darkness of all evil - but evil can't defeat Jesus and prevent Him from achieving what He came to the earth to do.

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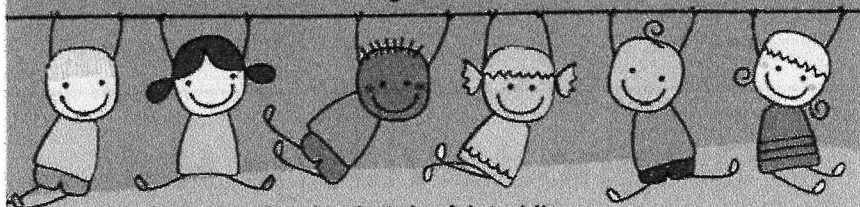
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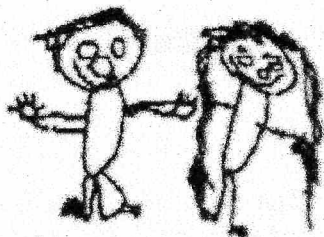
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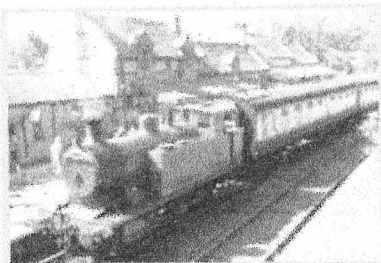
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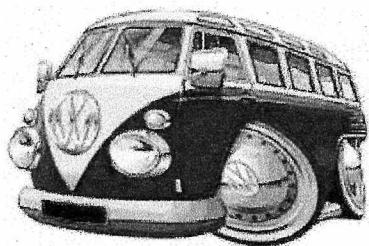
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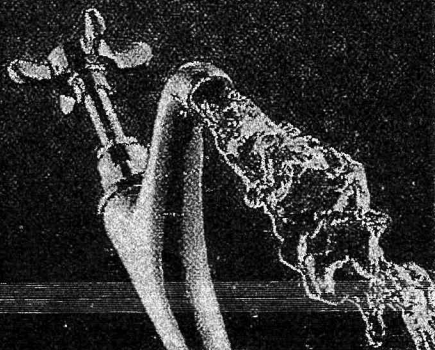


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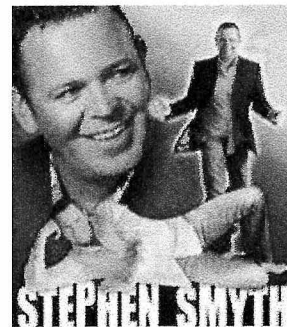
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BOON DAY APRIL 16th AT BLAWITH CHURCH

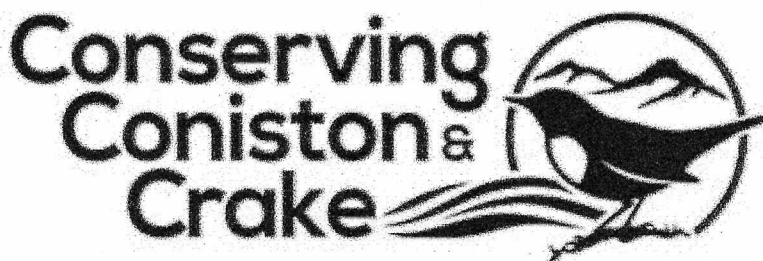
