

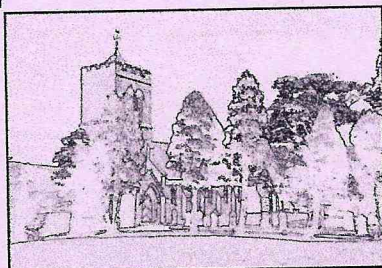

Pastoral Letter - Joanna Henson

Dear Friends

As I sit writing this at the beginning of another very hot day I am starting to feel a bit like Elijah's servant looking out for rain to end the drought that had afflicted the people of Israel. (If you want a good story read I Kings chapter 18). Day after day the gardens get drier and drier, and we do our best to keep them watered because we don't want to see our plants wither and die.

It set me thinking about the spiritual drought people seem to suffer from. There are all sorts of ideas to keep our souls "watered" but they are really of no avail in the face of continued drought. What can be done about it? Jesus's encounter with the Samaritan woman by a well offers us the answer. Jesus was hot, tired and thirsty when He stopped by a well and asked the woman for some water. She was a bit surprised as Jews didn't normally speak to Samaritans, and they got into conversation.

Curiously, Jesus said that He could give the woman living water and that she would never again be thirsty; which she took at face value and was rather glad, because that meant she wouldn't have to keep carting water back to her home.

Jesus explained that it was spiritual water that He was offering, "....those who drink the water that I give will never be thirsty again. It becomes a fresh, bubbling spring within them, giving them eternal life".

So how do you get some of this living water? Answer? By starting to get to know about Jesus. The invitation is there for you, personally, in the Gospels. Here is a lovely worship prayer written just for such an occasion when you decide to take a sip of this living water.

*Let Your living water flow over my soul,
Let your Holy Spirit come and take control,
Of every situation that has troubled my mind,
All my cares and burdens on to you I roll.
Father, Father, Father.*

*Give your life to Jesus, let Him fill your soul,
Let Him take you in His arms and make you whole,
As you give your life to Him, He'll set you free,
You will live and reign with Him eternally.
Jesus, Jesus, Jesus.*

*Come now Holy Spirit and take control,
Hold me in Your loving arms and make me whole,
Wipe away all doubt and fear and take my pride,
Draw me to Your love and keep me by Your side.
Spirit, Spirit, Spirit.*

*Let Your living water flow over my soul
Let Your Holy spirit come and take control,
Of every situation that has troubled my mind,
All my cares and burdens onto You I roll.
Father, Jesus, Spirit*

Knowing Jesus as a friend won't make you rich, it won't make you
bodily healthy, it won't keep you from harm's way, but it will bring
you contentment, peace of mind, inward calm and a loving
acceptance of what life brings along.

Why not give it a go?

Getting to know Jesus better...

This month we are continuing in John, chapter 1

English Standard Version of the Bible

Notes by **Matt Rich**, pastor of **Bethany Christian Church, Ulverston**

The next day he saw Jesus coming toward him, and said, "Behold, the Lamb of God, who takes away the sin of the world!

John calls Jesus "the Lamb of God", which was a reference to the sacrificial system that the Jews used to practice, where an animal would take their place and be killed instead of them. These sacrifices that they used to do pointed towards a person that was coming Who was pure and innocent, Who would take their place and be killed instead of them.

This is he of whom I said, 'After me comes a man who ranks before me, because he was before me.' I myself did not know him, but for this purpose I came baptizing with water, that he might be revealed to Israel."

John was older than Jesus but he says that Jesus is more important than he was, and that Jesus was before him - a recognition that Jesus existed in heaven before He came to the earth.

And John bore witness: "I saw the Spirit descend from heaven like a dove, and it remained on him. I myself did not know him, but he who sent me to baptize with water said to me, 'He on whom you see the Spirit descend and remain, this is he who baptizes with the Holy Spirit.' And I have seen and have borne witness that this is the Son of God."

John is explaining that Jesus is someone Who is more than a normal human being. Jesus is the Son of God... which means He has the same character and nature as God.

The next day again John was standing with two of his disciples, and he looked at Jesus as he walked by and said, "Behold, the Lamb of God!" The two disciples heard him say this, and they followed Jesus. Jesus turned and saw them following and said to them, "What are you seeking?" And they said to him, "Rabbi" (which means Teacher), "where are you staying?" He said to them, "Come and you will see." So they came and saw where he was staying, and they stayed with him that day, for it was about the tenth hour.

One of the two who heard John speak and followed Jesus was Andrew, Simon Peter's brother. He first found his own brother Simon and said to him, "We have found the Messiah" (which means Christ). He brought him to Jesus. Jesus looked at him and said, "You are Simon the son of John. You shall be called Cephas" (which means Peter).

These two disciples of John understood what John was saying - that Jesus was someone they should follow. They wanted Jesus to teach them... are we convinced who Jesus is? Do we want Jesus to teach us? Or do we think we know better than Jesus?

People were so excited that they had found Jesus - because they knew He had come to rescue them - that they went and told family and friends about Him. They encouraged others to follow Jesus like they were. If you are a Christian (a Christ follower), when did you last encourage someone who doesn't know Jesus to find out more about Him and follow Him?

Lowick Parish Council

The last Parish Council meeting was held on 17 May. This was the date for the Annual General Meeting. Councillor Longmire was re-elected as Chairman and Councillor Edmondson as Vice-Chair. Your other Councillors continue to be B. Mitchell, G. Sanderson and L. Ingham.

Richard Ellwood, Chairman of Lowick Green Management Committee, attended the meeting to clarify the work being proposed for The Green. He hopes to get a grant to undertake some drainage work and, hopefully, Young Farmers may help with cutting down some trees by the wall along the A5092. Grass cutting is a significant item in the budget but the majority local residents want this to continue. Councillors have notified CCC Highways about traffic issues but are awaiting a response about a site visit. Apparently, County Councillor Matt Brereton has been attending local PC meetings and, on the advice of Anne Hall, Lowick's issues will be forwarded to him for his support.

The Parish Council intends to take part in a litter pick organised by the LDNP on 06 July. It is hoped that this will be supported by members of the community. The meeting place will be The Green and the time advertised nearer the day.

Councillor Mitchell gave an update on the Kirkby Moor Wind Farm. It appears that SLDC say they have no grounds to enforce the reinstatement of the area to what it was; only the blades and turbines will be removed. Councillors feel strongly that this is unacceptable and will be following it up.

Councillors considered the paperwork associated with the Annual Audit and approved the accounts. These will be sent to the External Auditor and are available for the public to peruse from 11 June. Thank you to Mr Ian Curry who acted as our Internal Auditor.

The next meeting of the Parish Council will be held on 19 July at 7.30pm in Lowick Community Hall.
