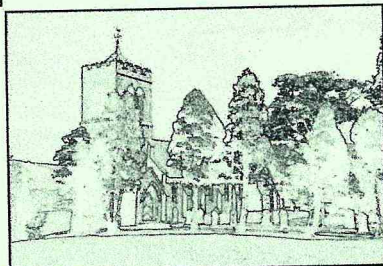

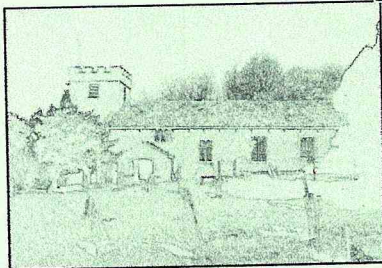

Pastoral Letter

EVIL

The word “evil” sounds to modern ears as being rather medieval, if you will pardon the pun. We think of evil as being something associated with a more primitive past, and yet we continue to use phrases like “the better of two evils” and we speak of “evil regimes”.

The use of “evil regime” as a descriptor for the Nazis in wartime Germany indicates that we are very happy to label distant and extreme persons as evil, but we appear to be less comfortable when speaking about people closer to home. And yet paedophiles are quickly labelled as evil in our own neighbourhoods.

But what if we move closer still? Is the husband who verbally or physically abuses his wife, evil? Is the boss at work who bullies and makes their employee's life a misery, evil? Is the ruthless businesswoman or man who stops at nothing to gain advantage or promotion, evil? Is the adult who never calls or visits their parents, evil? Is the person who throws rubbish out of the car window, evil? But let us bring it closer still – when I look in the mirror is the person staring back, evil? According to the Bible, evil is any thought, word or deed that does not align with the will of God, which is why Christians pray, “your will be done” in the Lord's Prayer. So, to answer the question, yes, the person staring back in the mirror is evil.

But God has solved our problem of evil by his son Jesus. Whereas, we are like Adam in the Garden of Eden following our own will and desires. Jesus, in the Garden of Gethsemane, said, “your will be done” to God – even when it meant death for him on our behalf. The only way for anyone to truly conquer evil in themselves is to truly trust and follow Jesus.

Getting to know Jesus better...

This month we continue to look at John, chapter 6

English Standard Version of the Bible

Notes by Matt Rich, pastor of Bethany Christian Church, Ulverston

Perceiving then that they were about to come and take him by force to make him king, Jesus withdrew again to the mountain by himself.

This is an interesting situation because the people wanted to make Jesus their earthly king but He didn't want them to because He hadn't come to rule here on earth. Instead, He had come to die on the cross to take the punishment they deserved for their sins. And He knew it wasn't just about them, there at the time... it was about a mission to help us too.

When evening came, his disciples went down to the sea, got into a boat, and started across the sea to Capernaum. It was now dark, and Jesus had not yet come to them. The sea became rough because a strong wind was blowing. When they had rowed about three or four miles, they saw Jesus walking on the sea and coming near the boat, and they were frightened. But he said to them, "It is I; do not be afraid." Then they were glad to take him into the boat, and immediately the boat was at the land to which they were going.

Jesus' disciples were experienced fishermen rowing hard, miles from shore. The sea was rough, the wind was strong and Jesus wasn't with them. How was Jesus going to get to the other side to meet them...? They would never have guessed what they were about to experience - Jesus walking on water!

When we read about something like this we either say "impossible, I don't believe it happened" or we say "wow!" People weren't scientifically knowledgeable back then but they still knew people couldn't walk on water... it would be considered just as much a miracle to them as it does to us. We are meant to read this and think, "that's normally impossible... Wow! Jesus is not just a normal man, He is someone special who I need to find out more about!"

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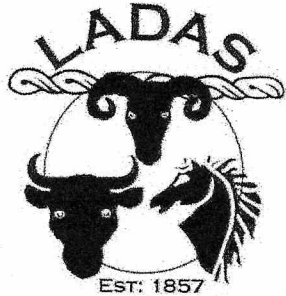
Lowick community Hall

Come and join us for the Lowick and District Agricultural Show! Our popular show is a celebration of the achievements of the local farming and wider community throughout the year.



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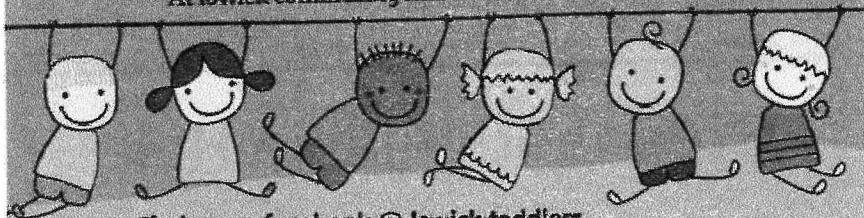

Lowick Parish Council

The last Parish Council meeting was held on 18 July.

Councillor Ingham received a helpful reply from County Councillor Matt Brereton with regard to traffic issues in Lowick. He has raised these with officers from Highways and is hopeful that there will be some action with Lowick's particular problems – re-siting the satnav sign; general signage; speeding – which will be part of a wider review in the area.

As part of the Parish Plan, Councillors have developed their particular items and there was a discussion about preparing a questionnaire which will be sent to all households. It is hoped to have a meeting early in September and Councillor Ingham undertook to prepare a questionnaire which will be discussed and refined before it is sent out.

Mr Ellwood, Chairman of Lowick Green Management Committee, reported that the wild flower areas have done well and he will be sowing some yellow rattle seed in the wild areas – courtesy of Cumbria Wildlife Trust. The old well is now flowing freely.

The Lengthsman has been out and about in the parish, strimming and tidying and is going to examine the bus shelters to see what work needs to be done to keep them in good repair.

Councillors discussed a planning application for the development of a barn into a dwelling at Woodgate. The Council is opposed to this development and will be responding to SLDC, giving reasons for this opinion.

The Southern Boundary Partnership information evening was held in the Community Hall on 3ed July.

Kirkby Moor Windfarm:

The Parish Council are very disappointed that the appeal has been allowed by the Planning Inspector, following the Public Enquiry. This means that the wind turbines will remain until 2027. This information came in after the meeting but will be on the agenda for the September meeting.

Unfortunately Police Community Support Officer Debbie Ross has had to take sick leave but if anyone needs to contact the Team, Sgt Rupert Johnston will be covering for her.

The next meeting of the Parish Council will take place on 19 September at 7.30pm in Lowick Community Hall. All are welcome. Remember to use the website **lowickpc.wordpress.com** for information about your parish and your parish council.
